

Things To Know Before Travelling

- Travel Insurance Is A Requirement.
- PCR testing must be done at an approved laboratory only.
- The UAE Dirham (AED) is pegged to the US Dollar at USD 1 = AED 3.66. Currency exchanges are widely available.
- Free internet calling services such as Whatsapp, Facebook, etc. are disabled in the UAE. It is recommended to get a roaming plan or pick up a local sim card

- It can get sunny, so stock up on sunscreen
- Wi-fi is available freely in most large malls, restaurants and in hotels.
- Convertor plug may be necessary for electronic items. UAE uses British style square, three-pin with a standard voltage of 220/240 volts at 50 Hz.

Things To Know Before Travelling

- Some prescribed medication maybe considered contraband in the UAE. Permission would be required from the UAE health authorities to bring in such medication.
- Tourists are automatically granted a 30-day liquor license upon arrival and can purchase alcohol from any licensed establishment using their passport.
- Strict dress codes are applicable in religious sites such as Mosques that are open to the public.

THE "DON'T DO" LIST

- Wear offensive or extremely revealing clothing in public areas.
- Use profanity or blasphemous language.
- Take pictures of strangers without their permission.
- Drink in public areas that are outside of licensed bars and restaurants.
- Import pork, contraband medication or pornographic material into the country.







Dhayah Fort


With a backdrop of steep mountains, the bay of Dhayah has always been a very fertile area and has been settled in at least since the third millennium BC. A conical shaped hill at the edge of the palm garden and at the foot of the mountains, served as a natural defense post for the oasis. People have used this hill since prehistoric times for settlement and fortification alike.

Today it is crowned by a fortress, built during the 19th century on the foundations of much older structures. It is the only hilltop fort still existing in the UAE and offers a fantastic view of the lush palm gardens, the sea and the dramatic mountains




Jebel Jais


Al Jazirah Al Hamra

Al Jazirah Al Hamra is the last authentic and traditional town still standing in the UAE. Once a small island, its inhabitants subsisted on maritime and pearl trading before they abandoned their houses in the middle of the 20th century, when the rush to modernize started. An undisturbed picture of life before the discovery of oil was left behind and preserved until today. This location is one of the best places to study traditional coral-stone architecture, used along the coast of the UAE.



Flamingo Beach


Flamingo beach is ideal for families; the shallow shores and lack of currents make the warm waters the perfect place to play games, learn how to swim or just relax and while away a weekend.
